

## **GENERAL INFORMATION FOR SUTLERS**

### **Revolutionary Rock Ford**

#### **Fees:**

- We are charging a sutler fee of \$30.00 for this event, which will cover wood, water, port-a-potties, music, and other expenses

#### **Dates:**

- October 19, 20, & 21, 2007

#### **Guidelines:**

- This event is based upon the time period of the American Revolutionary War, specifically 1777. Therefore, merchandise sold must represent the same time period.
- Merchandise sold must be period reproductions, antiques, or research materials.
- No food or candy may be sold.
- Period correct toys may be sold. No popguns, rubber band guns, rubber knives or tomahawks.
- Books, patterns, tapes, and other research materials relating to this period are acceptable.
- No cowboy, Tex-Mex, Western Indian, Medieval, Aleut, or Civil War items may be sold, displayed, or worn.
- You may sell to the event visitors: however, no slat back chairs, plastic swords, rubber knives or tomahawks, or other hot pink fluffy tourist stuff, please.

**Setup:**

- Camp will be open from Friday, October 19, 2007 at 12:00 noon and will remain open all night. Please schedule your arrival accordingly.
- Register upon arrival at the Tenant House (the small white outbuilding near the Mansion house.)
- Please do not set up before checking in.
- Set-up space will be pre-assigned and marked. Drew from G. Gedney Godwin will be coordinating sutlers.
- *No vehicles in the camp between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM Saturday, 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM on Sunday.*
- *No overnight parking in camp.*
- Please do not invite other sutlers or craftsmen, as they will be turned away.
- There will be no sharing of setups with sutlers that are not invited.
- Sutler camps and displays must follow standard BB/CL event guidelines for setup and display.
- Sutlers and their helpers must be in 18<sup>th</sup> century dress.
- All modern items must be covered or hidden from sight.
