

Welcome to Revolutionary Rock Ford 2007!

The camps are located on Williamson Road, up the hill and to the left of the Mansion House. Loop Road is a paved road with a wide berm off Williamson Road that may be used for loading and unloading.

Sutlers will be located at the corner of Williamson Road at Rock Ford Lane. Drew from G. Gedney Godwin should be on site to coordinate tent set up.

Parking: Reenactors are requested to park off Williamson Road in the field across from the camps (near the radio tower.) The overflow parking area will be near Pavilion #11 and Yeates Court further down Williamson Road. **PARKING WILL BE TIGHT!** Please park each other in if possible.

In the event that the fields are soggy, please park near Pavilion #11, Yeates Court, and on Farm View Lane to avoid tearing up the ground.

Sutlers, please park in the tennis court parking area on Golf Road. Please lock up your cars and do not leave valuables exposed - some of our neighbors are known to be less than hospitable.

Bathrooms: There are permanent bathrooms on Loop Road near the camps, as well as port-a-johns. There will be port-a-johns in the parking lot of the mansion house, and permanent bathrooms in the Barn. We do not have shower facilities.

Security: We have hired off-duty Lancaster County Park Rangers to patrol the area from 10:00 PM – 3:00 AM Friday and Saturday nights. They are sworn, armed police officers and if needed can be contacted through 9-1-1. West Lampeter Township and Lancaster City police officers are also aware of the encampment and may also come through the area.

Emergency Shelter: We have reserved Pavilion #11 on Williamson Road (just down from the camps) for the weekend. It is a large covered pavilion that can be used in case of emergency.

Ambulance: There will be a dedicated ambulance on scene from 10:00 AM – 4:00 PM both Saturday and Sunday for first aid and minor emergencies. The ambulance will be staged on Williamson Road down the hill towards the river from the Mansion House. If ambulance transport is needed they will contact another ambulance. After hours, an ambulance may be contacted by calling 911.

Local hospitals with Emergency Rooms are Lancaster General Hospital and Lancaster Regional Medical Center, both within 10 minutes of the site in Lancaster City. Lancaster General also has a trauma unit if needed.

Water: There will be a 2,000 gallon water truck in the area of the bathrooms on Loop Road. Water is NOT certified as potable so should be boiled if used for cooking. There is a water fountain at the permanent bathrooms for small amounts of water.

Hay, straw, and firewood: Will be available near the bathrooms on Loop Road.

Barn Dance: Will begin at 7:300 PM in the barn (where else?) The band Inishowen will provide music, but any other musicians are invited to join in. Cost is \$7, which covers light fare food, beer and soda, as well as paying the pipers.

Sutlers will be set up at the corner of Williamson Road and General Hand Lane.
